

Inspirational Title: Ship Ahoy	When: Autumn 2 Duration: 7 weeks
Hook: Trip to the Historic Dockyard in Portsmouth.	Outcome: Horrible Histories Film- Cross Federation- film afternoon with Holbrook to watch all their films linked to 'The Battle of Trafalgar'.
English: Drama based unit about Pirates (narrative linked to the text- 'A new home for a pirate') The children will write a non-fiction explanation unit based The Battle of Trafalgar. Poetry- 'Yo ho ho a pirating we'll go' / 'The Night Pirates' – poetry with rhyme.	Maths: Year 1 will focus on number and place value; addition and subtraction; fractions and geometry. Year 2 will focus on division; number and place value; addition and subtraction; measurement; fractions and geometry.
History/geography: Battle of Trafalgar: witness statements; life of a sailor of HMS Victory; recounts from the battle; differences between the Nelson's navy and our navy now; timeline of the events leading up to and during the battle.	Science: Year 1 - Pushes and pulls Yr 2 – Forces and movement
Computing:	DT: The children will design and make their own varieties of Winter Bread.
PE/games	Art: 3D work: HMS Victory, treasure chests. Clay work: artefacts from HMS Victory – cooking pots; cannons etc Flags and bunting for the pirate ships.
