

Inspirational title: <h1 style="color: red;">Predators!</h1>	When: Autumn 2	Long term plan: Duration: 6 weeks
Hook: The children will go on a trip to Marwell Zoo and take part in workshops.	Outcome: Bedenham Gallery. Parents will be invited in to our gallery to view the children's work from across the term. This is proposed for the week of 7 th December.	
English: We will study the text, Wolves in the Walls during literacy lessons. We will then use this as inspiration for our writing as we write letters to persuade, descriptions to inform to the reader, newspaper reports and a short narrative piece to entertain. We will also be writing reports about wolves. We will also study narrative poetry, focussing on the Highway Man.	Maths: This term we will focus on fractions, geometry and measure. Year 6 will also begin to look at ration and proportion. The children will investigate these topics in a variety of ways. We will continue our work from four operations too.	
History/geography:	Science: Year 5 will study Interdependence and Adaptation of plants and animals. We will investigate our local area thinking about the links that are evident there. We will also investigate how they survive and grow, thinking about the impact of different soils. Evolution and Inheritance will be the focus for year 6. Using all our previous knowledge of animals, plants and habitats we will be investigating how animals and plants have changed over time and examining the work of the scientist Charles Darwin.	
IT, Digital Literacy: The children will be exploring how the internet works. This will include how to stay safe online as part of our Anti-bullying week.	DT:	
	Art: To support our literacy, we will be studying photography and manipulating images of animals using IT. Further we will develop our collage techniques, including texture.	
PE/ Games: We will develop our gymnastics skills over the term; particularly thinking about extension, tension and control. We will also be taking part in mini circuit training activities, thinking about the impact of fitness on our health and how we can keep healthy.	Music: We will continue to exploring dimensions. We will look at tempo, texture, timbre and structure.
